to work. The team comes to a creative impasse, but the stakes are too high to give up. In hopes of drawing out their talents, they spend more and more time chipping away at each other. Previously hidden character traits come to light further complicating their relationship and the making of the film. Soon it's each man for himself. Just when the experiment seems utterly failed, one of them is discovered dead. It's not clear whether it's accident, suicide or murder, but a real body in the scene satisfies – this could be the start of The Film.

While people all over the world celebrated the victory over Nazi Germany in 1945, thousands of Latvian men went into forests to continue armed resistance against the occupying Soviet regime. Their belief of an imminent liberation war, led by American/ British forces, was fostered and used by the Swedish and British Secret Intelligence services who worked to engage the "Forest Brothers" into their own Cold War spy games with the Soviet KGB. Latvian refu-

gees, recruited as agents, were secretly sent into their occupied homeland to link up with the anti-Soviet resistance and gather information for the British SIS. Ill-trained and ill-equipped, their movements were known to the KGB due to reports made by Kim Philby and other British double agents – the operation was doomed from the start. Using unseen Soviet propaganda film excerpts, unique filmed KGB interrogation scenes and plasticine-animated reenactments, this documentary tells the thrilling, but hitherto little-known story, of the secret espionage war between the SIS and the KGB of so-called Soviet Latvia in the early years of the Cold War.
